



We are delighted to say we now have a system that will allow nets to be available to book for HNBCC members. The net use must be strictly in accordance with [Government rules on social distancing](#), [ECB Guidelines](#) and the following HNBCC temporary rules.

The opening of nets, and their availability will depend on suitable Club representatives (Club Rep) being available.

## **NO REPRESENTATIVE MEANS NO BOOKING = NO ACCESS**

### **IF YOU SEE SOMEONE NOT ABIDING BY THESE RULES – PLEASE REPORT TO THE COMMITTEE**

- Net use is limited to two people from different households maintaining 2 metres apart at all times, or a maximum of 4 people if you are exercising exclusively with members of your household.
- Social distancing of at least two metres must be maintained at all times. Please ensure that you park appropriately; avoid parking in close proximity to other vehicles. Where possible, Users of the Grass Net should park in the smaller car park, close to the entrance to the Ground.
- Do not arrive early, aim to arrive at the start of your slot to help with social distancing.
- Wash hands at home before and after using the nets, and bring your own hand sanitiser where possible. There will be limited amounts at the club.
- Only lanes 1 (nearest the pavilion) & 3 (nearest the tennis courts) can be used. The middle lane must not be used. Two grass nets will also be available to senior team players in the future.
- An approved Club Representative must be present on site at the club.
- Net use is limited to registered members of the club. We would like all those who wish to use the nets to have paid their membership but appreciate if this is not possible in these times. - Members are limited to participating in 1 session per day (subject to availability).
- **Nets must be booked in advance through the online system, see details below. DO NOT GO TO THE NETS WITHOUT A BOOKING.**
- Players must only use their own equipment (including balls) and must ensure it is clean and safe to use. Bowlers to use their own balls. Batters to knock or kick ball back to the bowler and not throw it as usual. The batter should not handle the ball.



- The only club equipment available will be stumps. The stumps and any other touch points, will be cleaned and sanitised after each session by the Club Rep. The bowling machine cannot be used.
- The clubhouse will continue to be closed and no toilet or other facilities will be available. Members are required to clear all rubbish after net use.
- All usual net rules apply including: no spikes; **no un-supervised use for under 16's; all under 16's must be accompanied by an adult who must remain for the whole session.** Full protection to be worn for hardball cricket etc.

With your first booking you will be required to complete registration with contact details including email and phone. Each booking session must be titled with all the household names using the net. Booking start times are limited to 11am to 7pm and each session booked will be confirmed by email on a first come, first served basis. E-mail confirmation to be used as proof of booking.

**When booking net one you are agreeing to be the Club Rep on site, if another has not been allocated, and this will be approved by the committee.**

Each booking is for a one hour session but nets must be vacated 10 minutes prior to the end of the session, to allow a 10 minute gap between bookings. Please wait away from the nets or in cars prior to the start of your session. Please leave the ground as soon as your session is complete.

In the interest of allowing all members fair access to the net facility the club reserve the right to impose restrictions or cancel any bookings without prior notice. Anyone found to be using the facilities without booking or not complying with [Government rules on social distancing](#), [ECB Guidelines](#) and HNBCC rules will be told to stop using the nets and may face disciplinary action from the Club. Antisocial behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in nets being closed for all.

**Enjoy the net use, stay safe and alert.**

Any damage to nets, or inappropriate use to be reported to the club committee members.
